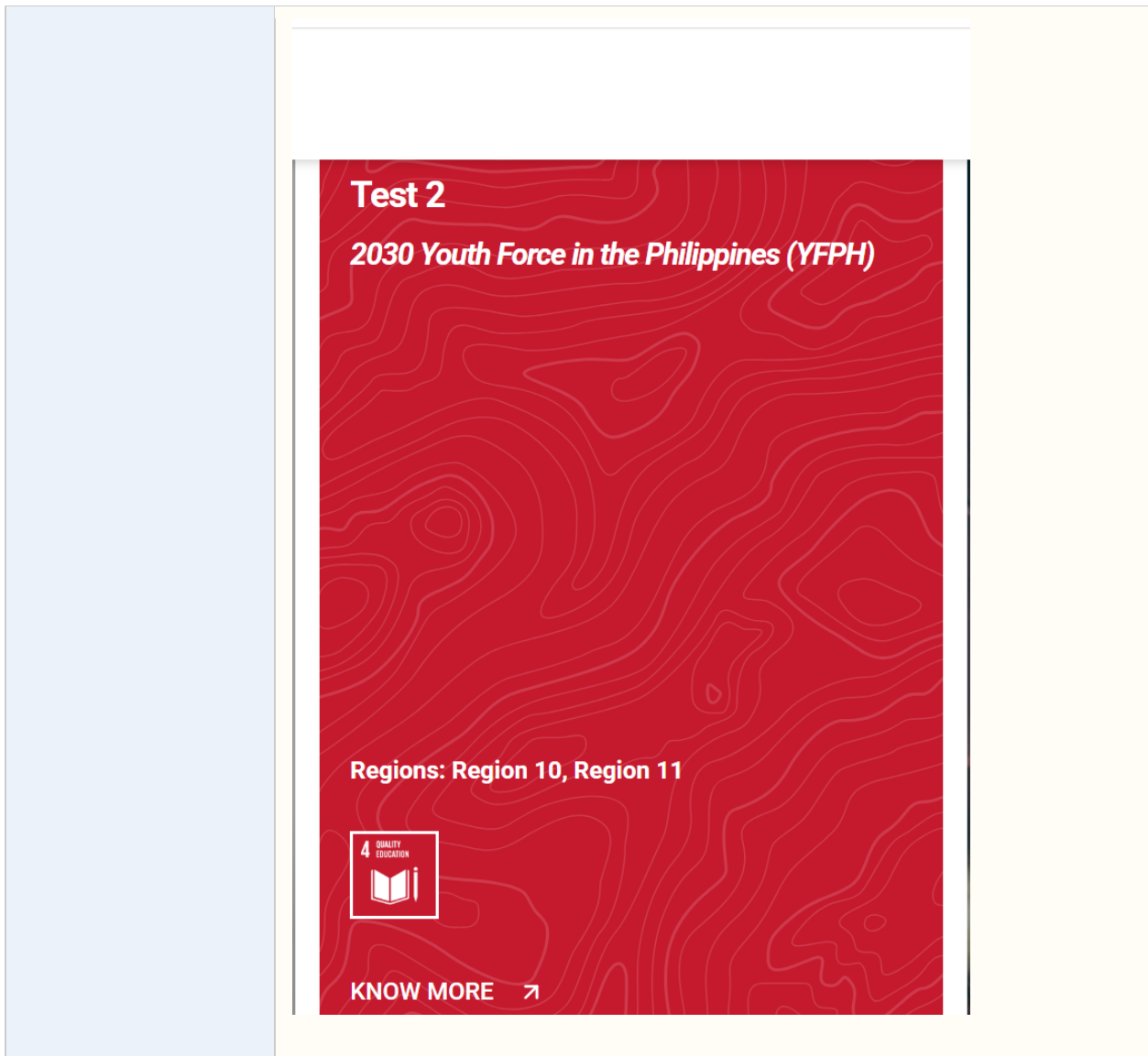

D20260316-05 Admin View   Projects (Photo Upload)	
<b>Issue Description</b>	The system rejects uploaded photos even when the file size (e.g., 1.08 MB) is within the stated 5 MB limit. Additionally, when a member submits a photo update for a PAP, the photo does not appear under the Admin's "Request for PAP Update" tab – only text revisions are visible.
<b>Type / Severity</b>	Bug / Enhancement   Severity: Low
<b>Current Status</b>	<b>Partially resolved.</b> The admin receives the update notification and text revisions are reflected. However, the uploaded photo is still not visible after acceptance.
<b>Expected Behavior</b>	The system should accept image uploads up to 5 MB. When a member submits a PAP update with a photo, the photo should be visible to the admin under the request details alongside text changes.
<b>UAT Script – Scenario 1 (Landing Page / Public View)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Open the SPACE Web App and navigate to the Login page.</li> <li>2. Log in using a Member account.</li> <li>3. Navigate to an existing, published PAP entry.</li> <li>4. Click "Request PAP Update" or the equivalent update button.</li> </ol>
<b>UAT Script – Scenario 2 (Logged In / Admin or Member)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In the PAP update form, upload a photo with a file size between 1 MB and 5 MB (e.g., 1.08 MB JPEG). <b>Expected Result:</b> The file is accepted without any error. A preview or filename confirmation is shown.</li> <li>2. Also update at least one text field (e.g., PAP description).</li> <li>3. Submit the update request. <b>Expected Result:</b> A success confirmation message is shown to the member.</li> <li>4. Log out and log in as Admin.</li> <li>5. Navigate to InSPACE &gt; PAP Management &gt; "Request for PAP Update."</li> <li>6. Locate the update submitted in step 3. <b>Expected Result:</b> Both the text revision AND the uploaded photo are visible in the update request details.</li> <li>7. Accept the update. <b>Expected Result:</b> The PAP entry reflects the updated text and the new photo on the public-facing page.</li> </ol>
<b>UAT Result</b>	<b>FAIL</b>
<b>Comments / Tester Notes</b>	The update request was approved, but only the description update was reflected. The new uploaded photo did not pop up.



D20260316-07 Admin View   Stories (Unpublish/Delete)	
<b>Issue Description</b>	When an admin unpublishes (archives) a story, the story still appears among the featured stories visible in a member's profile under the "Stories" tab. Additionally, there is no option to permanently delete an unpublished/archived story.
<b>Type / Severity</b>	Enhancement   Severity: Medium
<b>Current Status</b>	<b>Unresolved.</b> Archived stories remain visible in the member's featured stories list.
<b>Expected Behavior</b>	Once a story is archived/unpublished, it should be immediately hidden from all public and member-facing views. An option to permanently delete unpublished stories should be available to the admin.
<b>UAT Script – Scenario 1 (Landing Page / Public View)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Without logging in, navigate to the SPACE Web App public Stories page.</li> <li>2. Note the titles of stories currently displayed.</li> </ol>
<b>UAT Script – Scenario 2 (Logged In / Admin or Member)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Log in as Admin.</li> <li>2. Navigate to the "Stories" management page (Admin Dashboard or InSPACE &gt; Success Stories).</li> <li>3. Select an existing published story and click "Archived." <b>Expected Result:</b> The story status changes to "Archived" with a confirmation message.</li> <li>4. Log out and return to the public Stories tab without logging in. <b>Expected Result:</b> The unpublished story no longer appears in the public Stories tab.</li> <li>5. Log in as a Member account.</li> <li>6. Navigate to the Stories section within the Member's profile page. <b>Expected Result:</b> The unpublished story does NOT appear in the member's featured stories list.</li> <li>7. Log in as Admin again and navigate back to the Stories management page.</li> <li>8. Locate the archived/unpublished story and check for a "Delete" option. <b>Expected Result:</b> A "Delete" button is available for unpublished stories, allowing permanent removal.</li> </ol>
<b>UAT Result</b>	<b>PASS</b>
<b>Comments / Tester Notes</b>	After archiving, the story no longer appeared in the public and member views. The permanent deletion option worked successfully.

<b>Issue Description</b>	The "Add Resources" feature under "DEPDev" is encountering errors. Uploaded resources are not downloadable or readable. The system shows an error notification even though the file appears to have been uploaded.
<b>Type / Severity</b>	Enhancement/Bug   Severity: High
<b>Current Status</b>	<b>Partially resolved.</b> Admin can upload DEPDev resources. However, an error notification appears despite the file showing in the DEPDev tab. Downloadability remains unconfirmed.

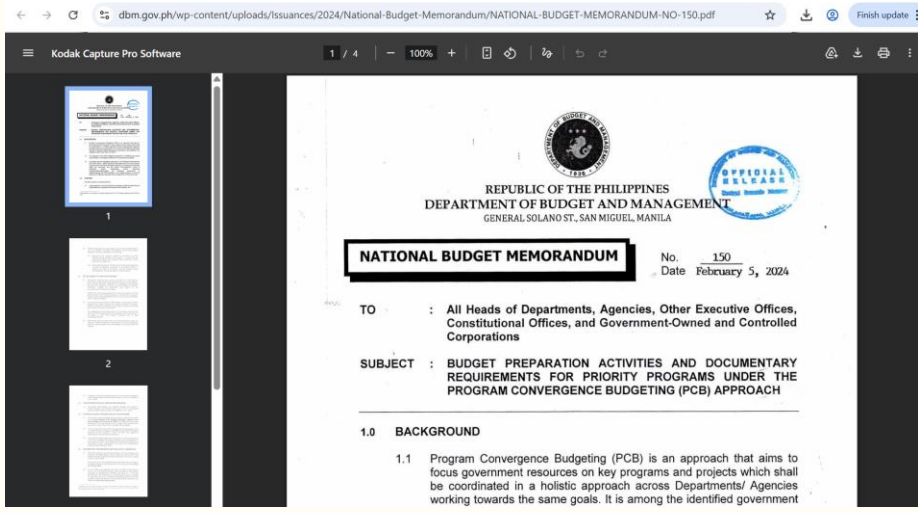

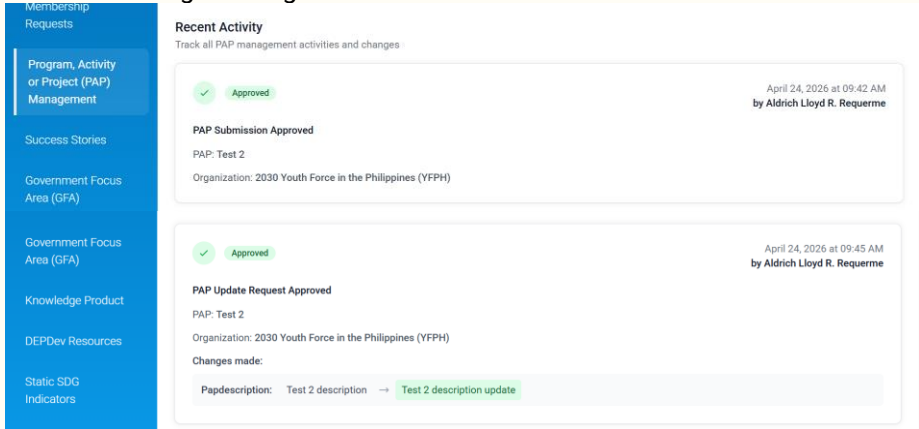

<b>Expected Behavior</b>	All new PAP actions (submission, update request, unpublish) should be logged in real time under PAP Management, with accurate timestamps and actor details.

<b>Type / Severity</b>	Bug   Severity: Medium
<b>Current Status</b>	<b>Resolved.</b> The admin email now receives notifications for PAP updates and new PAP submissions.
<b>Expected Behavior</b>	The system should automatically send email notifications to sdg-stakeholders@depdev.gov.ph whenever a member submits a new PAP or requests an update to an existing PAP or organization profile.
<b>UAT Script – Scenario 1 (Landing Page / Public View)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Open the SPACE Web App in a browser.</li> <li>2. Navigate to the public side and locate the "Contact" at the footer or notification trigger area (if accessible).</li> <li>3. Note the email address used for admin notifications: sdg-stakeholders@depdev.gov.ph.</li> </ol>

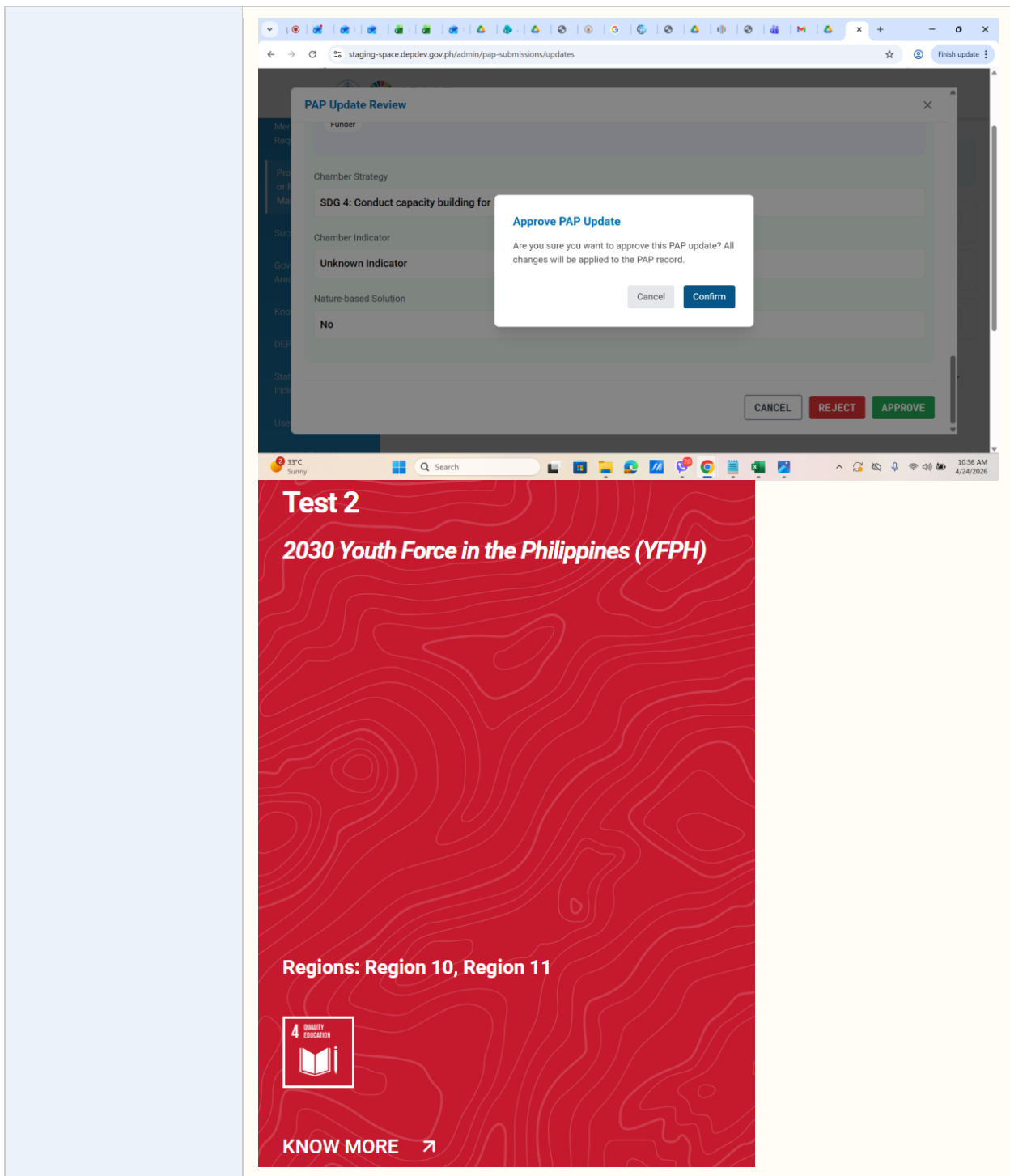
